SUGGESTED COURSE SEQUENCE FOR THE LITERATURE CONCENTRATION

1. If you're considering the Literature Concentration, take an English course that meets your Ways of Knowing/Humanities requirement:
ENG 1110 Literature and Faith
ENG 1220 Film and Faith
ENG 2221 Good Poems
ENG 2248 International Fiction
ENG 3334 US Multiethnic Literature
2. If you're committed to the English major, take your required 2000-level courses in your freshman or sophomore year. Academically talented students may take them as first-quarter freshmen. It is recommended that ENG 2251 be taken before ENG 2252:
ENG 2225 Literary Interpretation
ENG 2251 English Literature: Beowulf Through Milton
ENG 2252 English Literature: Restoration Through Victorian
ENG 2253 American Literature to 1900
3. Take your required 3000-level courses as a sophomore, junior, or senior.
4. Take your required 4000-level courses as a junior or senior.
