WHEREAS, he has fostered relationships with the student editors and remains in close contact with many of them, following their careers to this day;

WHEREAS, he has made yearly trips to the President's, Provost's, or Vice President's offices, fielded hundreds of telephone calls, letters, and emails from sometimes angry students, faculty, staff, coaches, administrators, and other members of the community with humility and patience;

WHEREAS, he was stoutly defended the importance of a free press and earnestly advanced the proposition that journalism, well done, is redemptive;

WHEREAS, he has done this while teaching full class loads, often overlords, and while completing a PhD, raising two children, and being a supportive husband to his wife, Chris;

WHEREAS, he is an active member of the Board of Student Media, has served on the Faculty Affairs Committee, and as an elder at Calvin Presbyterian Church, among other roles; and

WHEREAS, he has been a patient and gracious mentor, an outstanding teacher, a trusted advisor, a generous colleague, and friend; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that we congratulate **Richard P. Jackson** for his years of dedicated service to Seattle Pacific University, and we extend our heartfelt appreciation for his numerous contributions to the life of our community; and be it further

RESOLVED, that we bestow on **Richard P. Jackson** the status of *EMERITUS ASSISTANT PROFESSOR OF JOURNALISM*, with all the rights and privileges accompanying such rank, yet understanding that no title nor honor can fully convey our lasting appreciation and knowledge of how richly he has deserved all that is in our power to bestow.
